hereby declares that the rechargeable **Nickel-metal Hydride (NimH) Battery JWB2**, placed on the market for incorporation into the medical device products E-Move and E-Drive PLUS,

classified as LMT (Light Means of Transport battery),

with reference number MEM2001,

is in conformity with the Regulation (EU) 2023/1542 concerning batteries and waste batteries and complies with the requirements of Article 6 (restrictions on substances).

The battery is designed to address the objectives of Article 10 (performance and durability) and Article 14 (information on the state of health and expected lifetime), noting that detailed threshold values and related implementing acts for LMT batteries are not yet fully applicable.

The following standard has been applied when testing the battery:

- IEC 62133-1 Secondary cells and batteries containing alkaline or other non-acid electrolytes – Safety requirements for portable sealed secondary cells, and for batteries made from them, for use in portable applications – Part 1: Nickel systems

The above standard is applied as state of the art to demonstrate compliance with safety and risk control requirements in the absence of harmonized standards under Regulation (EU) 2023/1542.
